

## Poster Presentation Guidelines

Posters should be readable at a distance of three feet. The message should be clear and understandable without oral explanation. The following guidelines have been recommended to help improve the effectiveness of poster.

- The title should be the same as in the submitted abstract. Include the title of your presentation at the top of the poster. Author's name, College or Hospital name should also be displayed on the poster.
- 24 to 32 font size single spaced is recommended. The text should be concise and easy to read.
- use appropriate software (e.g. Adobe Illustrator, PPT)
- The poster dimensions should be 36\*48 inches/3ft length and 4ft width.
- Avoid abbreviations, acronyms, and jargon. Use a consistent font throughout.
- Figures and tables should cover about 50% of the poster area. If you have only a few illustrations, enlarge them. Do not omit text, but keep it brief.
- Don't overload your poster. Please remember that you are not writing an article.
